


Case study

THE CLIENT

The Arbib Education Trust, a multi-academy organisation comprising two primary schools and a large secondary academy, faced challenges in managing their eclectic and outdated print estate. SOS Systems stepped in with their ECO SMART service, re-engineering the print infrastructure to increase efficiency, reduce costs, and significantly improve service levels.

THE CHALLENGE

The Arbib Trust struggled with a disparate fleet of printing equipment acquired from three different manufacturers under varying framework agreements. Maintenance was burdensome, and Papercut a software designed to control wastage was only deployed across a small percentage across the fleet, across three different manufacturers, creating an inconsistent user experience. The subpar service levels under these agreements resulted in frequent downtime, affecting the productivity of both teachers and students.

OBJECTIVES

1. Measure the impact of the current print fleet.

- 2. Identify inefficiencies and areas for improvement.
- **3.** Implement Papercut improvements for reducing waste.
- **4.** Achieve considerable energy savings from the new fleet.

SOS Systems employed their ECO SMART process, which entailed comprehensive auditing and provided a roadmap to achieve these objectives.

ECO SMART is a comprehensive review of print and document processes of a business designed to help them improve their operations, reduce costs, and become more sustainable. The service takes a holistic approach to a business's print infrastructure, processes, and sustainability practices, identifying areas for improvement and implementing solutions that are tailored to the unique needs of each organisation.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

Four different vendors were considered. The Arbib Trust chose SOS Systems for their nuanced understanding of the challenges faced by the Trust and their proven track record in the education sector.

THE PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

The Trust decided to overhaul their printing equipment during the summer holidays. SOS Systems worked closely with IT providers, aligning the new print infrastructure with an ongoing serverto-cloud data migration project. New hardware was configured pre-installation to ensure a "plug and play" experience.
